It’s as if we are in the same room. There is no greater encouragement than praying with your family in Christ.

Since our last prayer letter, we have presented in 16 churches. Our **support has increased to 73%**. Each day, we get one step closer to reaching our goal and beginning our ministry in Portugal. During the **next two weeks, we will be part of missions conferences** in Tennessee and Michigan. We especially enjoy these times because we get to meet other missionaries and learn from their experiences. It’s also exciting to see such an emphasis on world evangelism.
